MEET YOUR INSTRUCTORS

JESUS

Hours before his betrayal and arrest, Jesus prays the final prayer of his earthly ministry. Knowing the brutal agony that awaits him, he lifts his voice to his Father, interceding for both his disciples and... YOU! Learn what Jesus desired for you and his followers above all else and how you can pray God's perfect will.

DAVID

Overlooked as a teen, hunted by the king he faithfully served, and betrayed by his own son, King David was no stranger to difficulty. In the midst of the intense pressures he faced, some of which he brought upon himself, the worshipping warrior poured out his heart to God in prayer. Learn from David how to give thanks to God when it feels like an army of problems surrounds you.

JEREMIAH

With a compassionate heart and faithful determination, Jeremiah repeatedly sounded the alarm to Judah that God's people were in danger of His judgment. The people ignored his prophetic pleas to repent and chose instead to cling to their idols. Then in 586 BC, Jeremiah's doomsday prediction comes to pass. Jerusalem is ransacked and the temple is destroyed by the Babylonian Empire. Instead of gloating over the stunning accuracy of his prophecy, "the weeping prophet" cries out to God in deep anguish. When everything around us is shaking, Jeremiah will teach you how to cling to an unshakeable God in prayer.

HANNAH

Year after year of disappointment had taken its toll. Mercilessly taunted by her rival, Hannah's burden of barrenness became more than she could bear. Throwing aside all forms of "prayer correctness," Hannah weeps bitterly, pouring out her soul before the LORD. Her desperation offends the sensibilities of an esteemed religious leader but moves the heart of God. Hannah will teach you how to pray when you're on the verge of losing all hope.

PRAYER LAB GUIDELINES

- 1. Prayer labs will last approximately 45 minutes. The first 15 minutes are for discussion and the last 30 minutes are for prayer. After the call, participants can stay on for additional 15 minutes to ask the leader any questions. A prayer lab leader might shorten or extend the time based on the group's feedback.
- 2. Prayer is a conversation with God. There's no need to attempt to impress others or be fearful that your prayer lab mates are evaluating your prayers. This is a safe environment for you to practice, learn, and make mistakes together.
- 3. Praying out loud in front of others can be intimidating. If praying out loud is a challenge for you, make it a point to pray at least once in your group each call to stretch yourself, even if it's just one sentence. You can only grow in confidence through stepping out in faith.

- 4. The group leader will share a Bible verse or verses at the beginning of the prayer lab that will serve as a target for the group to aim at. Group members should pray prayers that are aimed at "the target" so there can be unity and effectiveness in prayer.
- 5. Keep your prayers concise (30 seconds to a minute maximum). This allows everyone in your group to participate and helps your fellow prayer lab mates to stay engaged and agree with your prayer. You can always pray multiple times if time permits.
- 6. Mute your phone or computer microphone to eliminate background noise distractions.
- 7. Identify one person to record what's been prayed and any ways God has answered your group's prayers.
